### ONLINE COURSE/ ELECTION DISINFORMATION

AFP (**BROD**) offers courses to help monitor election campaigns and identify disinformation about candidates, parties, and the electoral system. Part two focuses on handling false claims and harmful content during and after election day.

### QUIZZES/ TEST YOUR MEDIA LITERACY SKILLS

**MedDMO** offers online quizzes to assess verification and fact-checking abilities, useful for both individuals and trainers in media literacy activities. Topics include synthetic content, conspiracy theories about climate change, and fact-checking.



### NEWS IN THE CLASSROOM DAY

On September 26, News in the Classroom Day (**BENEDMO**) will focus on improving news literacy, fact-checking, and fostering critical thinking. It emphasises active listening, discussing current affairs, and addressing sensitive topics while avoiding polarization in classroom discussions.

### Critical Thinking Workshops to Combat Misinformation

Demagog.sk (**CEDMO**) offers interactive workshops on critical thinking for both students and seniors. The workshops teach participants how to identify reliable information online, spot misinformation, and avoid cognitive biases. Sessions are tailored for different levels, from middle school students to advanced learners, helping them recognize argumentative tricks and build resistance to thought errors.



The Tartu Art Museum's exhibition “The Secrets of the Leaning Building” features a room focused on cyberbullying called “Stop Bullying – Make Your Message Safe!”. Created in collaboration with **BECID**, it displays real instances of online bullying shared by students, along with suggested responses to curb further harm. Visitors interact with the exhibition by identifying suitable responses and exploring underlying reasons for bullying. A wall of phone cases invites people to share their digital mistakes, fostering learning. The exhibition will extend online via KiVa's website, featuring expert advice.
